

# TIMETABLE and ON THE DAY HIGHLIGHTS



## Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June:

- Normal 'lilac' timetable in operation (10.30, 12.15 + 14.00 ex Wharf)
- Wharf Café open from 09.00-11.00 for breakfasts, and then throughout the day.
- Beer Festival at Wharf open from 12.00 to 23.00.
- Llechfan Garden Railway running into the evening at Wharf.

## Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2023:

- Intensive timetable all day! All available locos on passenger trains: can you ride them all?
- Wharf Café open from 09.00-11.00 for breakfasts, and then throughout the day.
- Llechfan Garden Railway running at Wharf
- Beer Festival at Wharf open from 12.00 to 23.00, with live music in the evening from talented local band Back2BackTrax.
- 'Alf's Outing': a morning trip to Abergynolwyn (departs Wharf at 09.15, returns 12.26), with a mid-morning breakfast break at Abergynolwyn
- 'Y Shuttle': two diesel-hauled morning shuttles (with 11+12) to bring passengers from Rhydyronen campsite to Tywyn Wharf for breakfast
- Double-headed goods (10.45 ex Wharf): No.2 will pilot No.6 on a goods train to Brynglas, before No.6 carries on solo to Abergynolwyn
- Two demonstration goods trains to Abergynolwyn and return (10.45 + 14.30 ex Wharf, 1245 + 1615 ex Abergynolwyn).
- Busy blocking at Brynglas! Look out for unusual loco swaps and movements happening here throughout the day, keeping the blockman on his (or her) toes. This celebrates 70 years of Brynglas being used as a passing loop, as trains first crossed here in July 1953.
- Demonstration trolley run with 'Toby' to Abergynolwyn and return (13.25 ex Wharf, 15.10 ex Abergynolwyn)
- 'The Old Lady Vintage': a leisurely lunchtime departure with No.2 and the vintage train
- 'The Tea-Chime Express': a late afternoon run with No.3 and No.6, in time for tea and cake at Abergynolwyn. Enjoy the sounds of chime whistles (from an A4 and a Brit) echoing across the valley!
- 'The Shunter Shuffle': depart Wharf hauled by one Baguley, and come back with another! No.11 will haul the train to Brynglas, where you will swap locos with No.12 to take you on to Abergynolwyn and return.

- Grand gathering of locos at Wharf (17.00 onward)
- Travelling to the Beer Festival...? Two diesel-hauled shuttles to bring passengers from Rhydyronen campsite to Tywyn Wharf for the evening (18.00 + 18.20 ex Rhydyronen)
- Two loco cavalcades: 18.45 from Wharf to Pendre and return (steam) + 19.15 from Wharf to Pendre (diesel).
- Live music at Wharf in the evening from talented local band Back2BackTrax.

## Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2023:

- Busy service throughout the day, featuring all available locomotives on passenger trains
  - Beer Festival open at Wharf 12.00 until 17.00 (or whenever we run out of beer)
  - Wharf Café open from 09.00-11.00 for breakfasts, and then throughout the day.
  - Llechfan Garden Railway running at Wharf
  - 'The Non-Stop' (celebrating the 150 anniversary of the opening of the Glyn Valley Tramway): an unusual non-stop steam-hauled run from Wharf to Nant Gwernol, featuring No.7. Departs 09.35, returns 11.45 (including a refreshment break at Abergynolwyn on the return)
  - 'Breakfast with Alf': a leisurely trip up the line, featuring an extended breakfast break at Abergynolwyn to photograph the 'non-stop' special in both directions. Abergynolwyn cafe will be serving sausage baps etc. Departs 09.00, returns 12.26.
  - Demonstration trolley runs with 'Toby' to Brynglas (10.00 ex Wharf) and Abergynolwyn (13.25 ex Wharf)
  - 'The Old Lady Goods': 11.00 goods to Brynglas with No.2
  - 12.45pm ex Wharf: 'Coronation Special', recreating the original Coronation Special, which ran 70 years ago on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 1953. This train will run with the original headboard (weather permitting), with thanks to the Narrow Gauge Railway Museum.
  - Banking to Brynglas: the 2pm ex Wharf will be banked by No.3 as far as Brynglas.
  - Demonstration goods train to Abergynolwyn (2.30pm ex Wharf)
  - Photo line-up at Wharf (15.30 onwards), inc. Glyn Valley, Corris and Talyllyn vintage trains
  - End your weekend with a late afternoon trip up the line with No.2 and the vintage set, featuring photographic run-pasts at Dolgoch.
- This is a curtain-raiser for our next special event (Heritage Weekend' 23<sup>rd</sup> 24<sup>th</sup> September). Will you be joining us again?
